

MUSC 01H: Honors Music History: Medieval, Renaissance and Baroque Periods

This course is a survey of music history from medieval times through 1750, including cultural, intellectual, and social issues. The instructor provides an in-depth examination of the development of Western music through analyzing and synthesizing historical details and stylistic elements of the musical trends of the era. Music History uses the same methods common to all honors courses: writing-intensive, collaborative, and experiential instruction. As an honors course, there is a focus on critical writing and exploring the field of study across disciplines.
