- The final cohort of the Fostering a Community of Belonging is now open for enrollment for Spring 2025. Open to faculty (associates too), staff, and administrators. See Rebecca Cisneros-Diaz or Michelle Francis for questions.
- The Office of Student Needs now provides umbrellas, and ponchos for students in need or for those who take the bus to school. Rain jackets and rain boots can also be provided for those students who meet eligibility (i.e. house insecure, etc.).
